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2. Data Management Policy

HEALTHCARE DATA MANAGEMENT POLICY

Pursuant to the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (General Data Protection Regulation, GDPR), Act CXII of 2011 on the right to informational self-determination and freedom of information (Infotv.), Act CLIV of 1997 on Health (Eütv.), and Act XLVII of 1997 on the management and protection of health and related personal data (Eüak.), as well as the NM Regulation 62/1997 (XII. 21.) on certain issues of managing health and related personal data (NMr.), Oboler Kft (Theta Pest) as the Data Controller adopts the following rules for the management of personal data related to healthcare services:

Purpose of Data Management: Data management is based on the voluntary, informed, and explicit consent of users when using the "send message" function on the website.

Legal Basis for Data Management: Based on Section 5 of Act CXII of 2011 on the right to informational self-determination and freedom of information, the user's voluntary consent.

Data Managed: Mandatory data provided by the user during the message sending process: name, phone number, email address.

Purpose of Data Use: The Service Provider may use the email address and phone number provided by the visitor for contact purposes.

During the use of the website, data recorded in log files are stored exclusively for technical and statistical purposes. An anonymous visitor identifier, such as a string (cookie), cannot identify the user but is suitable for recognizing the visitor's device. Users can configure their browser to prevent unique identifiers from being placed on their devices (usually in the settings menu under tools/internet options, depending on the browser). In such cases, users can still use a significant portion of the service, although certain features, such as customized solutions, may not be fully utilized.

The Data Controller does not use personal data for purposes other than those specified.

Duration of Data Management: Messages sent by users are managed in the Data Controller's email account for purposes of response, retrieval, and contact until the user requests the deletion of their personal data.

Data recorded in log files during the service's use are stored by the system. The time of the last visit is automatically overwritten by the system during the user's next visit.

Deletion of Personal Data: Users must send a deletion request regarding their personal data via email to thetakozpont@gmail.com. The Service Provider deletes the data within five working days of receiving the deletion request. Once deleted, displayed data cannot be restored.

Personalized Content: During visits to our website, one or more cookies containing a character sequence are sent to the visitor's computer, allowing their browser to be uniquely identified. These cookies store only the fact and time of the visit to the site, with no other information.

The use of cookies sent in this way includes the following:

- External service providers, including Google, use these cookies to store if a user has previously visited the advertiser's website, and based on this, display ads to the user on internet websites of external service providers, including Google's partners.

- Users can disable Google's cookies on the Google Ads opt-out page. (They can also disable cookies from external service providers on the Network Advertising Initiative's opt-out page.)

Legal Enforcement Options: Users may enforce their rights before the court based on Act CXII of 2011 on the right to informational self-determination and freedom of information and the Civil Code. They may also request the assistance of the President of the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information. User Consent: By clicking the checkbox next to the "send" button before sending a message, users acknowledge and accept the terms of [thetapest.hu](https://www.thetapest.hu)'s user conditions and data management policy.

Governing Law: In matters not regulated in this document, the provisions of Act CXII of 2011 on the right to informational self-determination and freedom of information, Chapter XVII of Act C of 2003 on electronic communications, and Government Decree 226/2003 (XII. 13.) on the specific conditions of data management and data security of electronic communication services, as well as Act CVIII of 2001 on electronic commerce and certain issues of information society services, shall apply.

The Data Controller states that the general data protection principles, rules, rights, and obligations defined in the GDPR and Infotv. are recorded in the Data Management Framework Policy. This Healthcare Data Management Policy is inseparable from and supplements the Data Management Framework Policy. Where this Healthcare Data Management Policy (hereinafter referred to as Eü.Szab.) does not contain specific provisions, the general rules in the Data Management Framework Policy (hereinafter referred to as Keretszab.) apply.

Provisions Regarding the Electronic Healthcare Service Space (EESZT):

The EESZT is a state-centralized IT system that stores and transmits electronic healthcare data. Starting November 1, 2017, all publicly funded healthcare service users' health data are included in this central database, where they are stored for five years after death. The transmission and storage of data are mandatory, and all clinics, general practitioners, and hospitals are required to transmit data here. The medical system used by the Data Controller automatically transmits personal data to the central information system. The Data Controller cannot influence the transmission process.

Individuals can access all their healthcare data here. To use the EESZT residential portal, an Electronic Client Gateway ID, password, and Social Security Identifier (TAJ) are required (accessible from home via the Client Gateway). The official EESZT information is available on the EESZT Information Portal (<https://e-egeszsegugy.gov.hu/>).

The affected individuals can regulate access to data stored in the EESZT by determining which treating physicians can access what data and documents, and when. The access restrictions set by the affected individual do not apply when a state authority, organization (court, prosecutor's office, investigative authority, infraction authority, secret service, government office, etc.) submits a data request to the Data Controller or the operator of the

EESZT system based on law, or when mandatory data transmission is ordered by law, which the Data Controller and the operator of the EESZT are obliged to comply with.

The Data Controller is not liable in any form for incomplete or erroneous healthcare resulting from restrictive measures made in the course of the right to self-determination.

The mandatory “Information on the processing of personal data in the Electronic Health Service Space during healthcare provision in the medical institution” information is available on the website of the Data Controller.
